MONOPHONE TYPE 80 — CONVERSION TO 2-TONE COLOR —

1. CONVERSION

When the subscriber wishes his installed black type 80 Monophone converted to 2-tone, you need not replace the entire instrument, but only the housing.

- 1.1 Unscrew the 3 non-losable screws in the baseplate, remove the housing, and operate the hooklock to keep the line clear.
- 1.2 Inside the cover, essentially halfway between the hookswitch plungers, is a #6-32×3/8" P.K.F.R.H. screw holding the cradle-hole cover (plunger stop). Remove this screw.
- 1.3 Transfer the cradle-hole cover, the screw, and the 2 plungers to the colored housing.
- 1.4 Place the new housing in position on the old instrument, and tighten the 3 non-losable screws in the baseplate.
