2.00 GENERAL

- 2.01 The information contained in the tables does not include class of service or transmission zoning requirements. This information may be found in detail in the sections covering the specific sets.
- 2.02 Equipment for use where inductive noise is encountered is covered in the C Section on inductive noise.

2.03 Refrigerating and freezing rooms do not require special sets, but do require special treatment of sets as covered in a separate C Section.
