## **DESCRIPTION AND USE**


## 1.00 GENERAL

- 1.01 This section gives a brief description of the various types of backboards and lists their uses in table form. It is reissued to include additional information on color and to bring the section up to date.
- 1.02 Due to extensive changes, marginal arrows have been omitted.
- 1.03 Backboards should not be used except where a secure mounting could not be otherwise obtained.

146A	Metal	Black	Type 433, 633, or 653 subs. set either with or without a 148A backboard. To be used when writing space is required. 6-3/4 by 9-1/2 inches with a 7-1/2 by 6-3/64-inch shelf.
147A	Wood	Black	Type 433, 633, 634, or 653 subs. set or a type 50 recorder-connector on a wall or over an outlet. Use with metal subs. set on metal lathed or sheathed walls as protection, and with masonry or brick walls where the surface does not allow easy location of holes for the screws in the subs. set. 9-9/16 by 7-1/8 inches.
148A 148B	Wood	Black	Type 433, 434, 633, 634, or 653 subs. set and a 7A or 7J coin collector. When writing space is required, the 148A backboard can be used in combination with a type 433, 633, or 653 subs. set and a 146A backboard. In this case the coin collector, if required, is mounted separately on a 150A backboard. The 148A backboard is 18-13/16 by 7-1/8 inches and the 148B is 18-1/4 by 7-1/8 inches.

Note: These 3/8-inch holes are not provided in the 172A, but may be drilled in the field to accommodate type 554, 556, or 558 telephone sets. The top hole is usually provided for the type 558 set, and the bottom hole for types 554 and 556 sets.
