The L M Ericsson PAX type ARD 636 for 30 stations is desinged for small and mediumsized offices, factories, stores, warehouses, hospitals etc. Calls are dialled and automatically switched in the unattended switchboard equipped with crossbar switches of international repute. These switches are also used in the wellknown Ericsson public exchanges delivered all over the world. Speed of operation, large handling capacity and practically no maintenance cost are characteristic features of the Ericsson Crossbar equipment.

- One and two digit extension numbers.
- Automatically repeated ringing signals.
- Individual transmitter feed ensures efficient speech transmission.
- First party release.


- Priority for optional number of extensions.
