

Special Products.

We're making our telephone service more and more convenient. All kinds of phones...for every purpose...home and office.

Speaker Phone. Move around the room. Invite anyone in the room to join in the conversation. "Go to it" with both hands free.

Code-Com Set. For those totally deaf or blind, you can "communicate" in coded messages using light flashes and disk pulses. Anyone can use it and all without a word.

Signalman¹ Control Relay. If your hearing is impaired, a flashing lamp signals a phone call. Volume Control. Handsets for those with speech

Colors.

Custom Calling.

Now your phone can hold a call for you, let you talk to two friends at once, forward your calls and even let you dial shorthand. These are our exciting, new Custom Calling features. They can be added to every phone in your home without even changing the phones themselves. Because Custom Calling is not available everywhere, please ask your Service Representative about your area.

Call Waiting. When you're in the middle of a conversation and someone else is trying to call you, your phone will tell you so by signaling that you have a call waiting. You can then put your first call on "hold" and answer the second. You can even switch back and forth between the calls.

Call Forwarding. Now you never have to miss a call just because you're away from home. Call Forwarding will actually transfer your calls to any other phone you choose. Your incoming calls are automatically switched to the new number, without your caller even being aware of it.

Three-way Calling. This feature lets you make three-party conference calls for the price of one call. It's especially helpful when you're planning an upcoming event and three people have to be in on the planning. It's a cost saver on three-way long-distance calls, too.


Speed Calling. If you find yourself calling the same numbers frequently, you'll really appreciate Speed-Calling. It lets you dial only a one-to-three digit code phone number, instead of the usual seven-to-eleven. You can order Speed-Calling for either 8 or 30 numbers.




Putting it all together.
