# HAND SETS E2A-3, E2B-3 AND E2C-3 DESCRIPTION AND USE

# 1. GENERAL

1.01 This section gives general information pertaining to the E2A-3, E2B-3 and E2C-3 hand sets, such as their use, description, piece parts, and the combination of apparatus that is included in the code number.

# 2. DESCRIPTION

2.01 The E2A-3, E2B-3 and E2C-3 types of hand sets use four conductor cords and are shown in Fig. 1.



# 3. USE

- 3.01 The **E2A-3** type hand set has a cord terminated in a plug and is for use in central offices, on P.B.X.'s and with order turrets.
- 3.02 The **E2B-3** type hand set has a special receiver and is for use with a hand set mounting for local battery talking, common battery signaling anti-sidetone connections.
- 3.03 The **E2C-3** type hand set is for use with a hand set mounting in connection with apparatus for subscribers with impaired hearing.

# 4. APPARATUS

- 4.01 The E2A-3, E2B-3 and E2C-3 type hand sets consist of the following apparatus and piece parts:
- (a) One E2-3 Hand Set Handle
- (b) One Receiver as follows:

(d) One 395B-3 Transmitter

(f) The E2A-3 hand set also has a 137 plug included as part of the assembly code.
