DESK STANDS 20, 40, 50, 51, 52 120, 140, 151 and 152 TYPES DESCRIPTION AND USE

1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This section gives general information pertaining to desk stands such as their use, description, equivalents, and piece parts.
- 1.02 The 20, 40, 50, 51 and 52 type desk stands are for use with subscriber sets arranged for sidetone connections. The 120, 140, 151 and 152 types are for use with subscriber sets arranged for anti-sidetone connections.
- 1.03 Dials: The 2AA, 2AB and 2AE dials are used for the desk stands covered herein. The 2HA, 2HB, 2HE or 4HA, 4HB, 4HE type dials may be substituted for the corresponding 2A types by strapping the BB and R terminals with strap per P-290076.
- 1.04 **Apparatus Blanks:** The 50E apparatus blank is used on all desk stands requiring apparatus blanks except the 50 type, which use the 50D apparatus blank.

3. DESCRIPTION

3.01 A fully equipped desk stand requires a receiver, transmitter, cords, number card holder and in the case of the 50, 51, 52, 151 and 152 types, a dial or apparatus blank. The desk stand code number includes only such parts as a base assembly, base plate assembly, handle, lug holder, terminal plate with contact spring assembly and switchhook. These parts are shown in Fig. 1.

DESK STAND SHOWING PRINCIPAL PARTS BY NAME


