

B-, C-, G-, AND J-TYPE RELAYS

PIECE-PART DATA AND REPLACEMENT PROCEDURES

1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the information necessary for ordering parts to be used in the maintenance of C- and J-type relays and two styles of B- and G-type relays. The old style B- and G-type relays are referred to as Initial Design while the new style B- and G-type relays are referred to as Modified Design. The Modified Design may be distinguished by bushing inserts in the adjusting plate. It also covers approved procedures for replacing these parts.

1.02 This section is reissued to incorporate material from the addendum in its proper location. In this process marginal arrows have been omitted.

1.03 Part 2 of this section covers the piece-part numbers and the corresponding names of the parts which it is practical to replace in the field in the maintenance of the relays covered by this section. No attempt should be made to replace parts not designated. Part 2 also contains explanatory information is called Piece-part Data.

1.04 Part 3 of this section covers approved procedures for the replacement of the parts covered in Part 2. This information is called Replacement Procedures.

2. PIECE-PART DATA

2.01 The figures included in this part show the various parts in their proper relation to the other parts of the relay. The piece-part numbers of the various parts are given together with the names of the parts as listed by the Western Electric Company Merchandise Department. Where these names differ from those in general use in the field, the latter names, in some cases, are shown in parentheses.

2.02 Information regarding paper armature stops for the B- and G-type relays and paper backstops for the B-, G-, and J-type relays is covered in Section 040-506-701 for the B- and G-type relays and Section 040-512-701 for the J-type relays.

2.03 When ordering parts for replacement purposes, give the piece-part number as well as the name of the part. Example: P-15A612 Cover Cap. Do not refer to the BSP number or any information shown in parentheses following piece-part numbers.

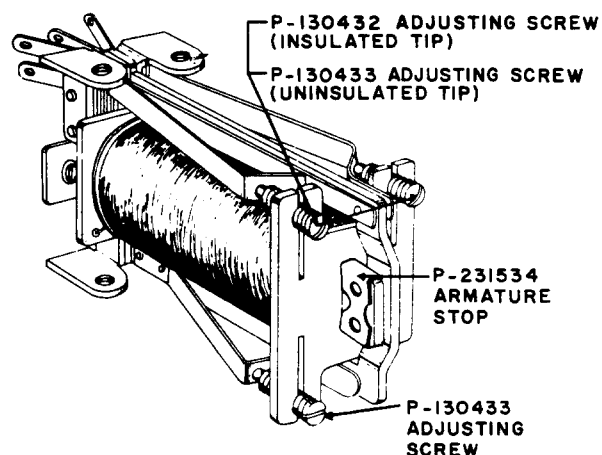
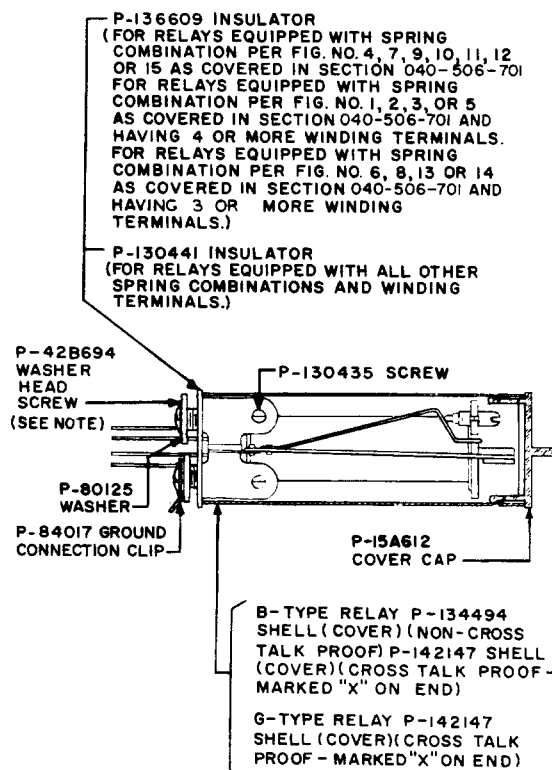


Fig. 1 - B- and G-type Relays - Initial Design

Fig. 2 - B- and G-type Relays - Bottom View - Initial Design

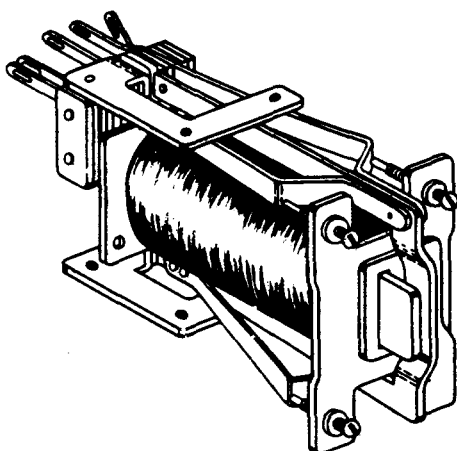
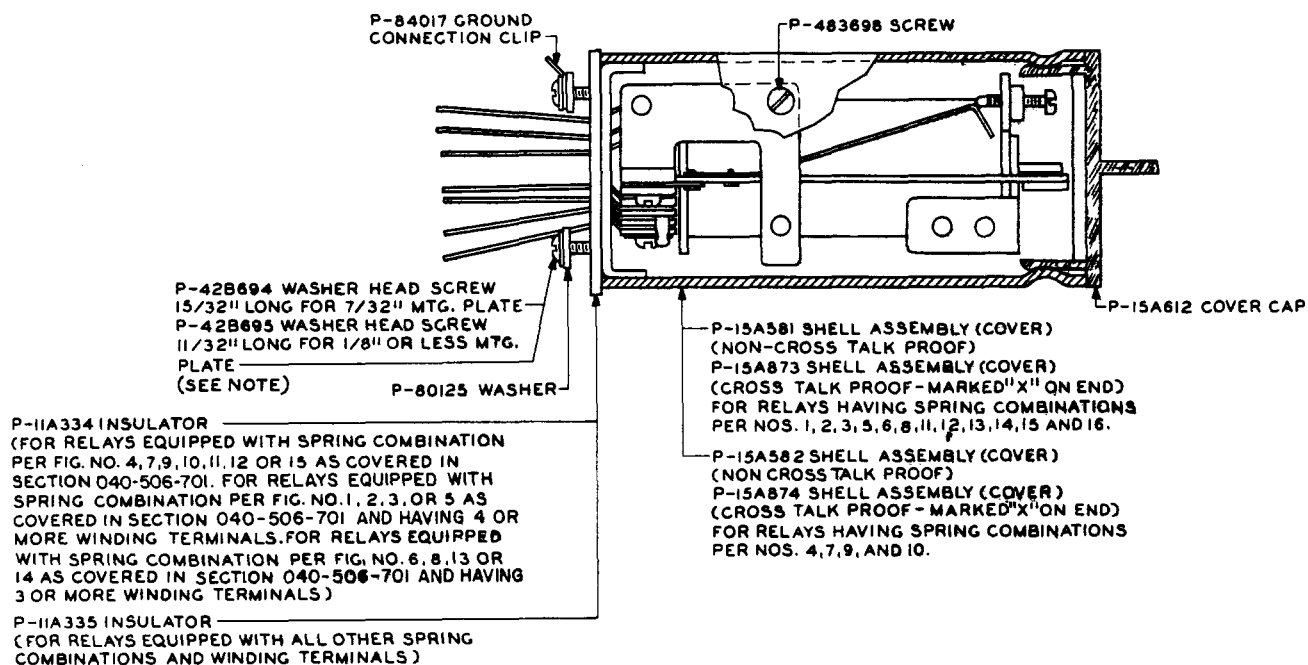


Fig. 3 - B- and G-type Relays -

Modified Design

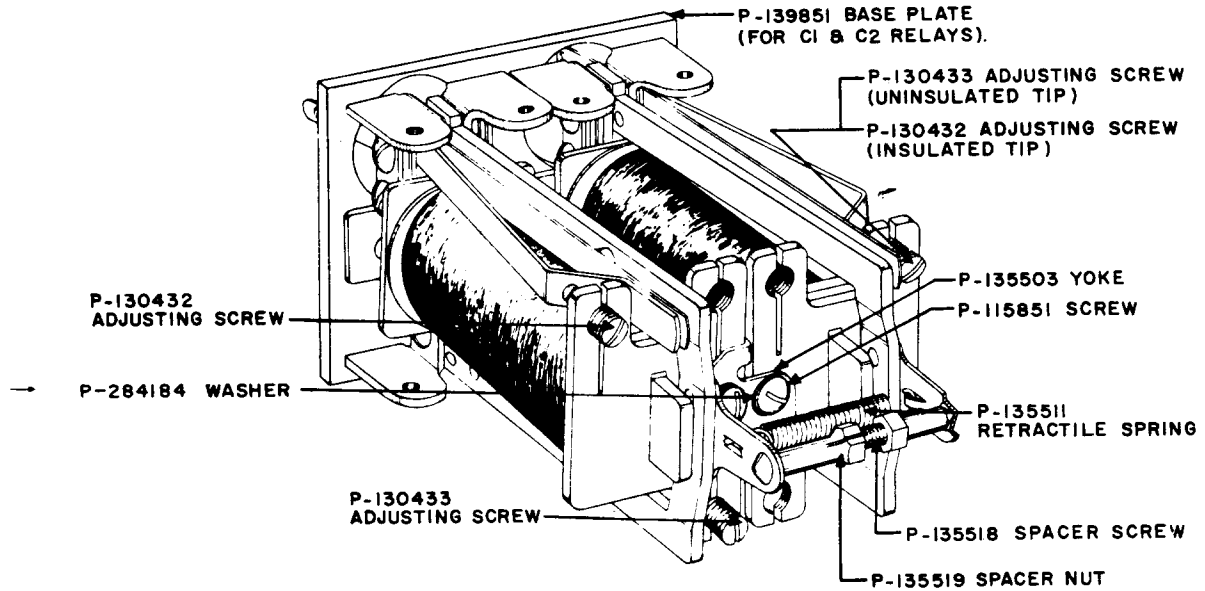
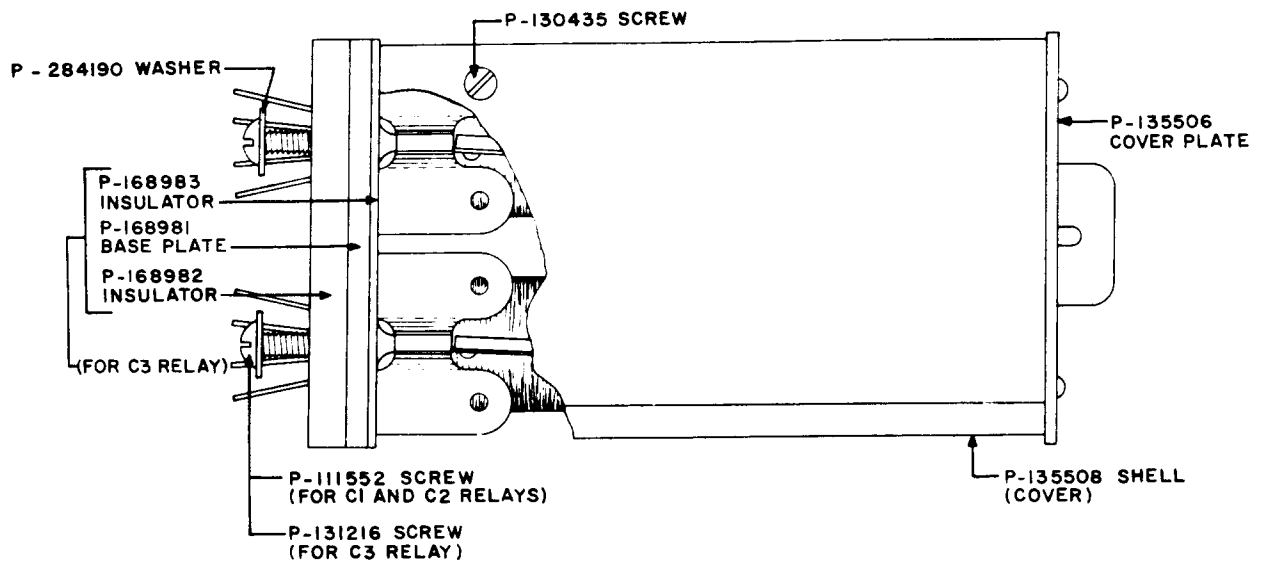


Fig. 5 - C-type Relay

Fig. 6 - C-type Relay - Bottom View

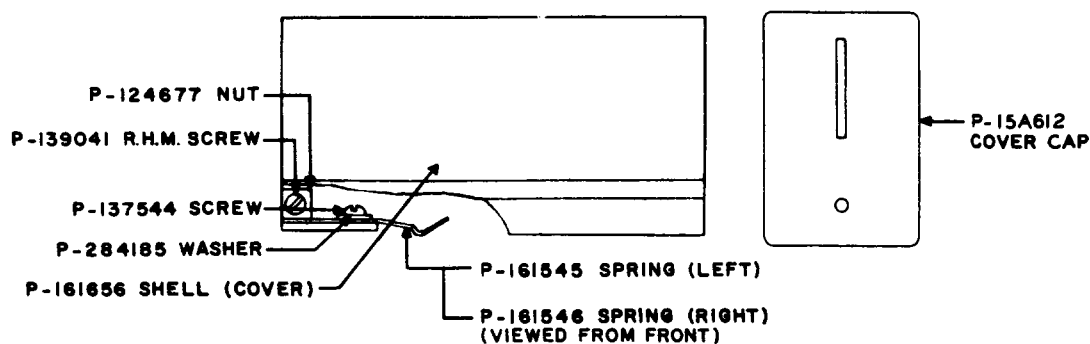

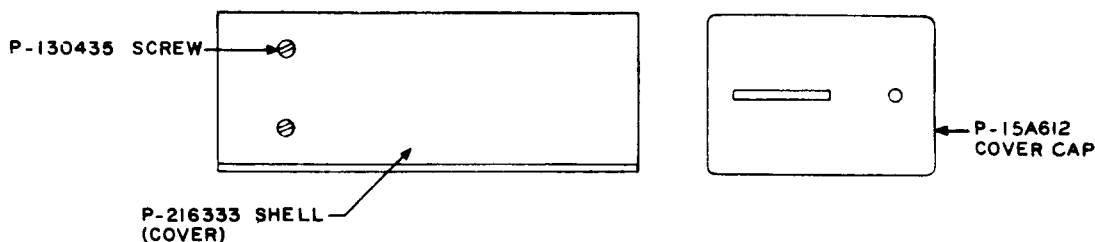

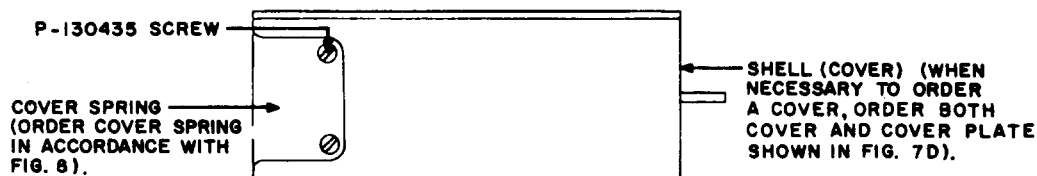
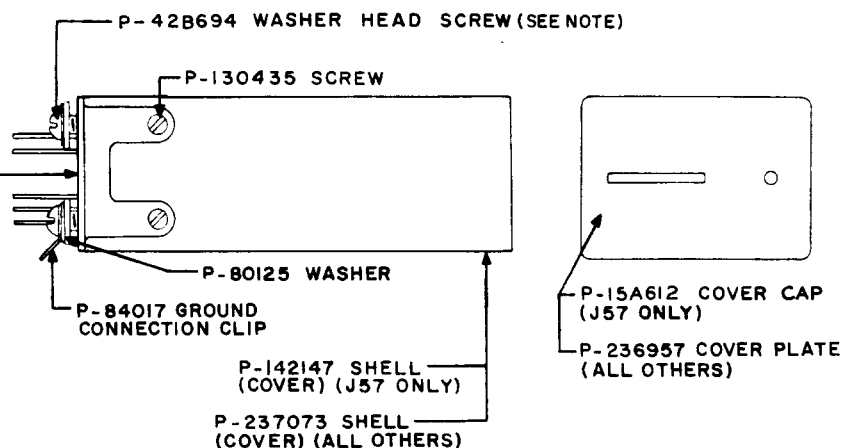

Fig. 7 - Shells (Covers) and Cover Plates for J-type Relays

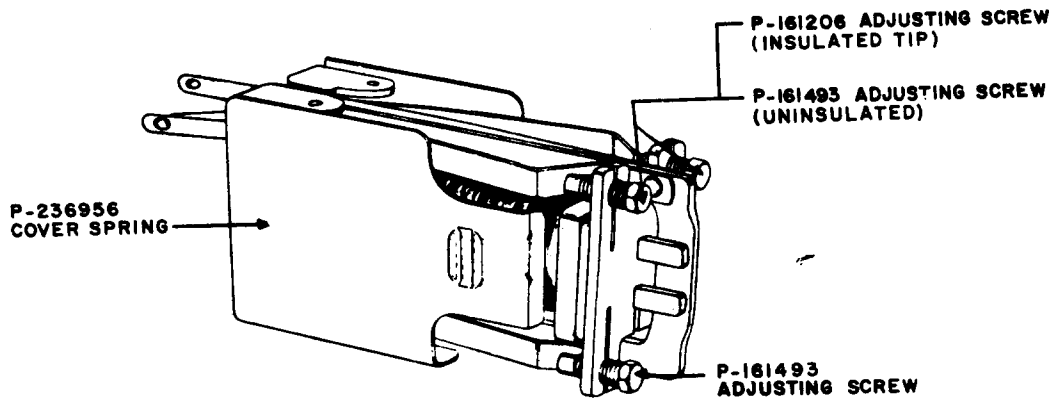


Fig. 8 - J-type Relay

3.002 After making any replacement of parts of a B-, C-, G-, or J-type relay, the part or parts replaced shall meet the readjust requirements involved as specified in Section 040-506-701 for the B- and G-type relays, Section 040-508-701 for the C-type relays, and Section 040-512-701 for the J-type relays. Other parts whose adjustments may have been directly disturbed by the replacing operations shall be checked to the readjust requirements and an over-all operation check shall be made of the relay before restoring the circuit to service.

3.003 No replacement procedures are specified as the replacement consists of simple operations.
