1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This section covers Form SW-6153

 Log Record Line Finder Call

 Blocked Alarms (Exhibit 1). This form
 is designed for use in step-by-step
 offices for recording call blocked alarms
 as they occur.
- 1.02 Data from a record of call blocked alarms, along with other data such as subscriber "no dial tone" reports and "dial tone delay" studies, are useful in revealing the line groups which may re-

quire remedial action to correct an unbalanced load condition.

- 1.03 This log record may be prepared to cover specified uniform periods, such as a day or a week or, when few entries are required, one form may be continued in use until filled.
- 1.04 The Form headings are self explanatory.
- 1.05 Form SW-6153 is available in pads of 25 sheets each.
