

EXPANDED ELECTRONIC TANDEM SWITCHING DIALING PLAN  
FEATURE DOCUMENT

1. GENERAL

1.001 This addendum supplements AT&T Practice 231-390-383, Issue 2. Place it ahead of Page 1 of the practice.

1.002 This addendum is issued to provide the ability to store the ETS (Electronic Tandem Switching) Authorization Code for EEDP (Expanded ETS Dialing Plan) class II calls in the XMDR (Expanded Message Detail Record). This enhancement is applicable only to ETS customers that have both the EEDP and the ETSBES (ETS Billing Improvements).

2. CHANGES TO PRACTICE

2.001 On Page 3, add a new paragraph 1.11.1 to read as follows:

1.11.1 The ETSBES capability is available in the Periodic Partial Update Issues 1AE8A.11, - 1AE9.06, 1AE10.01 and later generic programs.

2.002 On Page 9, add a new paragraph 3.04.1 to read as follows:

3.04.1 The ETSACRE adds approximately 230 words to the base (core) for customers with the EEDP feature.

2.003 On Page 11, add a new paragraph 4.08.1 to read as follows:

4.08.1 The ETSACRE keyword is added to the RC:CUSTCB message as an optional keyword below the XDO keyword. This keyword indicates the ability to store the ETS authorization code for EEDP class II calls in the XMDR. Keywords ACPFX and ACLGN must be input if ETSACRE is input. The option word F, bit 21 of the Private Network Customer Services Supplementary Auxiliary Block is set to 1 if the customer will receive the ETSACRE feature.

2.004 On Page 13, add a new paragraph 4.09.1 to read as follows:

4.09.1 The V-CUSTID input message provides verification of the ETSBES capability. The only change to this message is to add the keyword ACR.

V-CUSTID-ACR bbb.

[where bbb is the ETS CUSTID (customer ID) 064 through 127]

System response is the TR90 CUSTID output message containing the customer's ETSACRE b indicator.
