

## B SIDING CLIP (AT-8939) DESCRIPTION AND USE

### 1. GENERAL

1.01 This section covers the description and use of the B siding clip (AT-8939). The clip is used to fasten drop or station wire on aluminum house siding.

1.02 Whenever this section is reissued, the reasons for reissue will be given in this paragraph.

### 2. DESCRIPTION

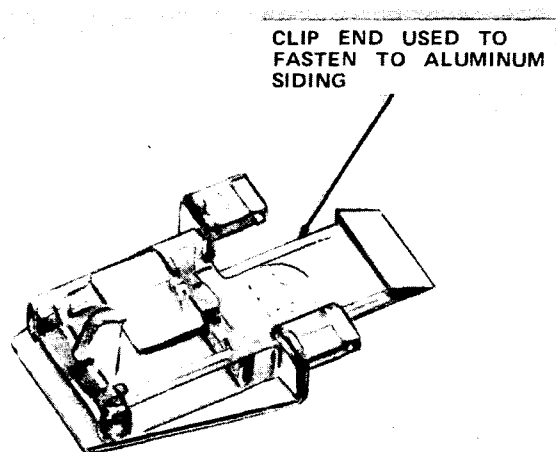


Fig. 1—B Siding Clip

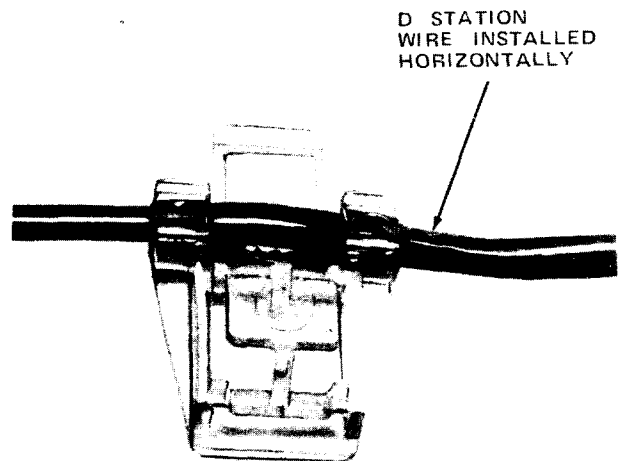


Fig. 2—D Station Wire Installed

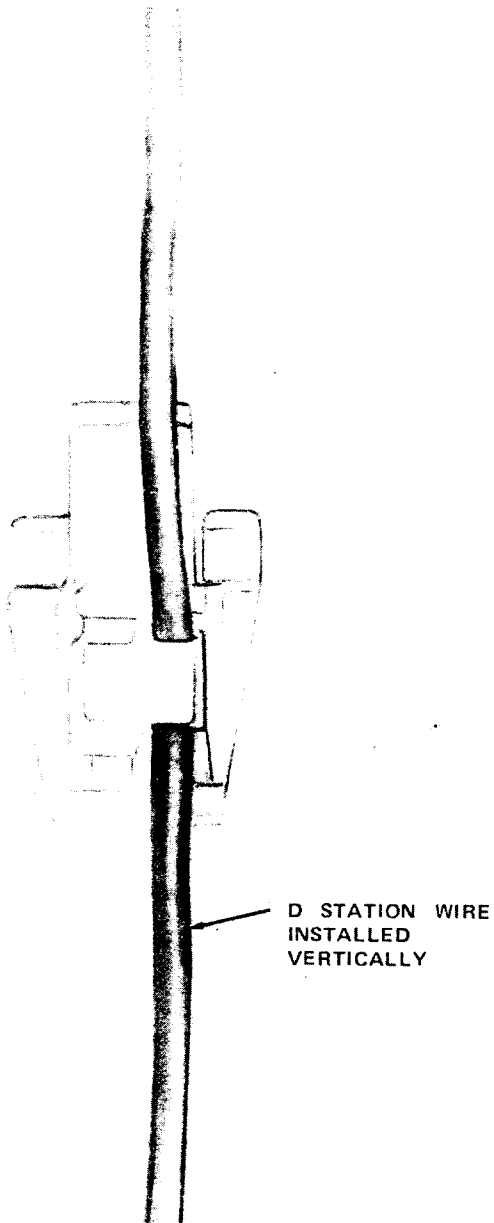


Fig. 3—D Station Wire Installed Vertically

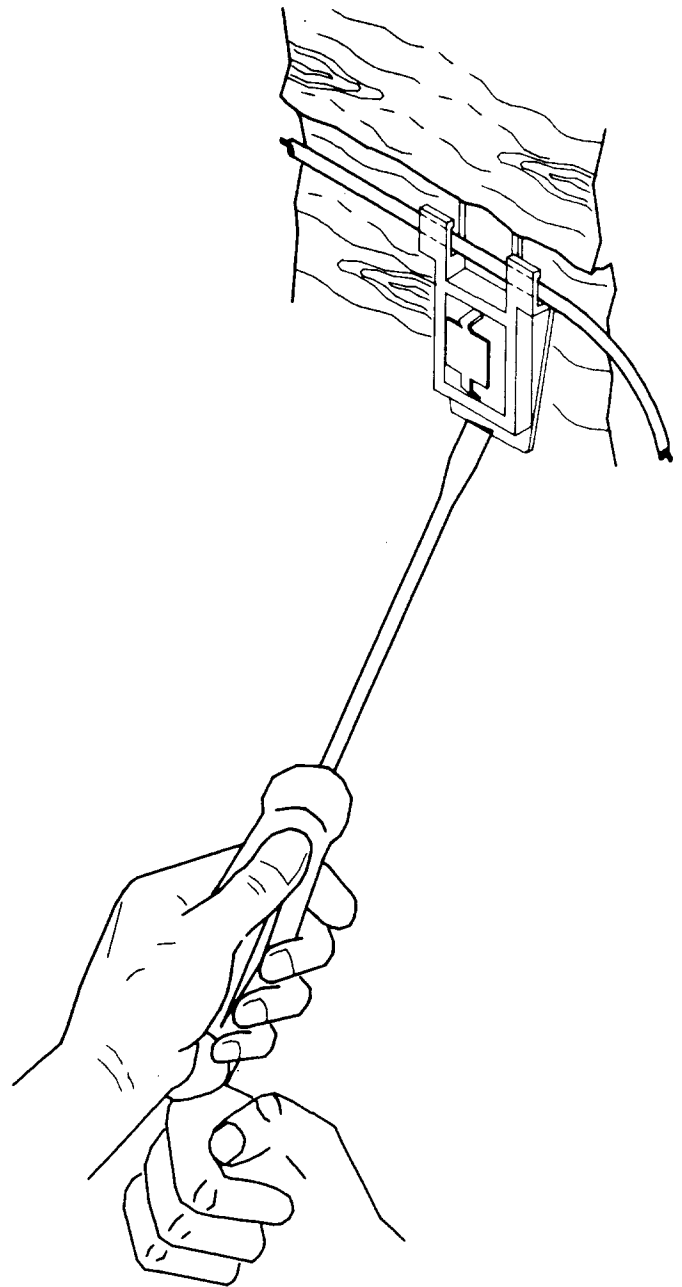


Fig. 4—Installing B Siding Clip

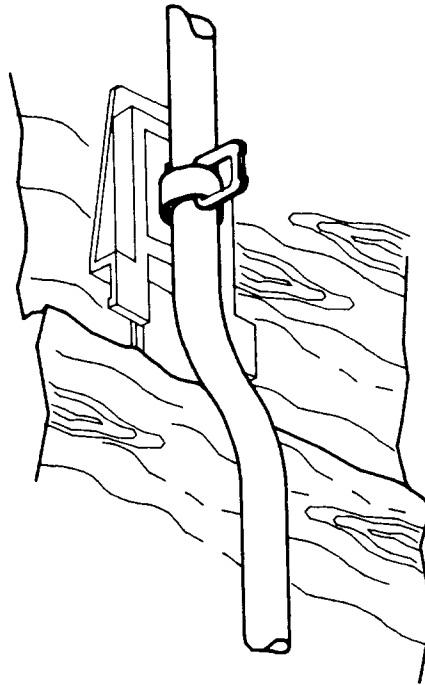


Fig. 5—Service Drop Cable Secured With Cable Tie

2.01 The B siding clip (AT-8939) is a molded one-piece clip that is made of clear plastic (Fig. 1). The clip is intended to fasten single or multiruns of station or drop wire to aluminum siding on houses in a vertical or horizontal position. D station wire is shown installed on the clip in Fig. 2 and 3. Typical building installations are shown in Fig. 4, 5, and 6.

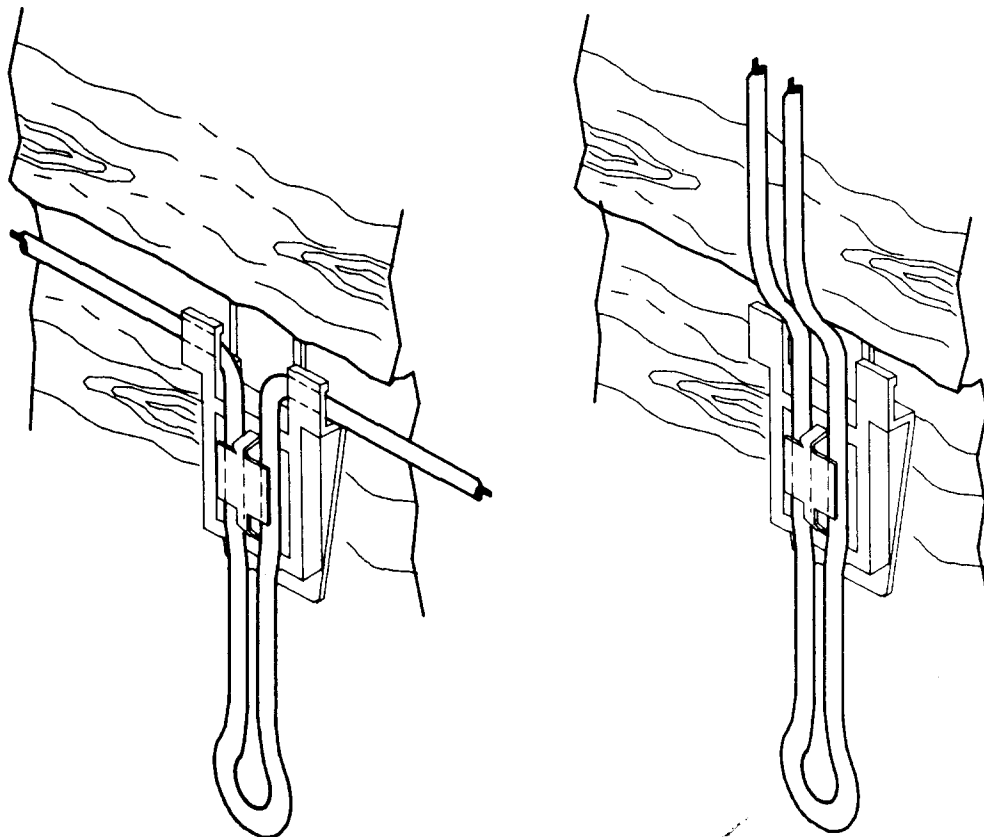


Fig. 6—Double Run of Station Wire Installed Vertically or Horizontally
