TELEPHONE SETS

554, 556, AND 558 TYPES

DESCRIPTION AND USE

1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This section covers the description and use of the 554-, 556-, and 558-type telephone sets.
- 1.02 The 554- and 556-type sets will replace the 354 and 356 types, respectively.
- 1.03 The 558-type sets are single-button sets which provide the same features as the 510-type sets.

2. DESCRIPTION

- 2.01 The general appearance of these sets is shown in Figs. 1 and 2. A 95B apparatus blank replaces the dial on manual sets.

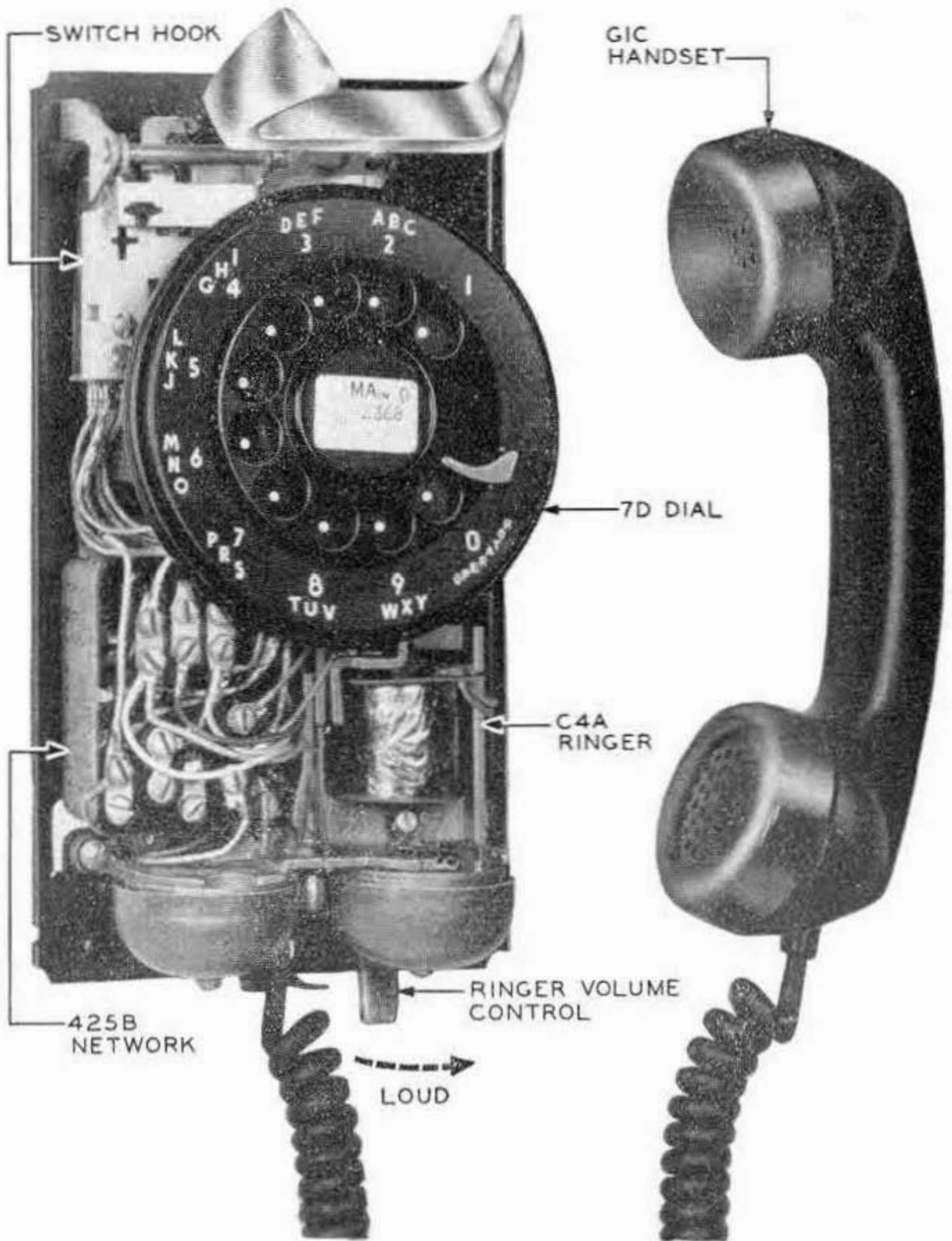


Fig. 3—554BR Telephone Set

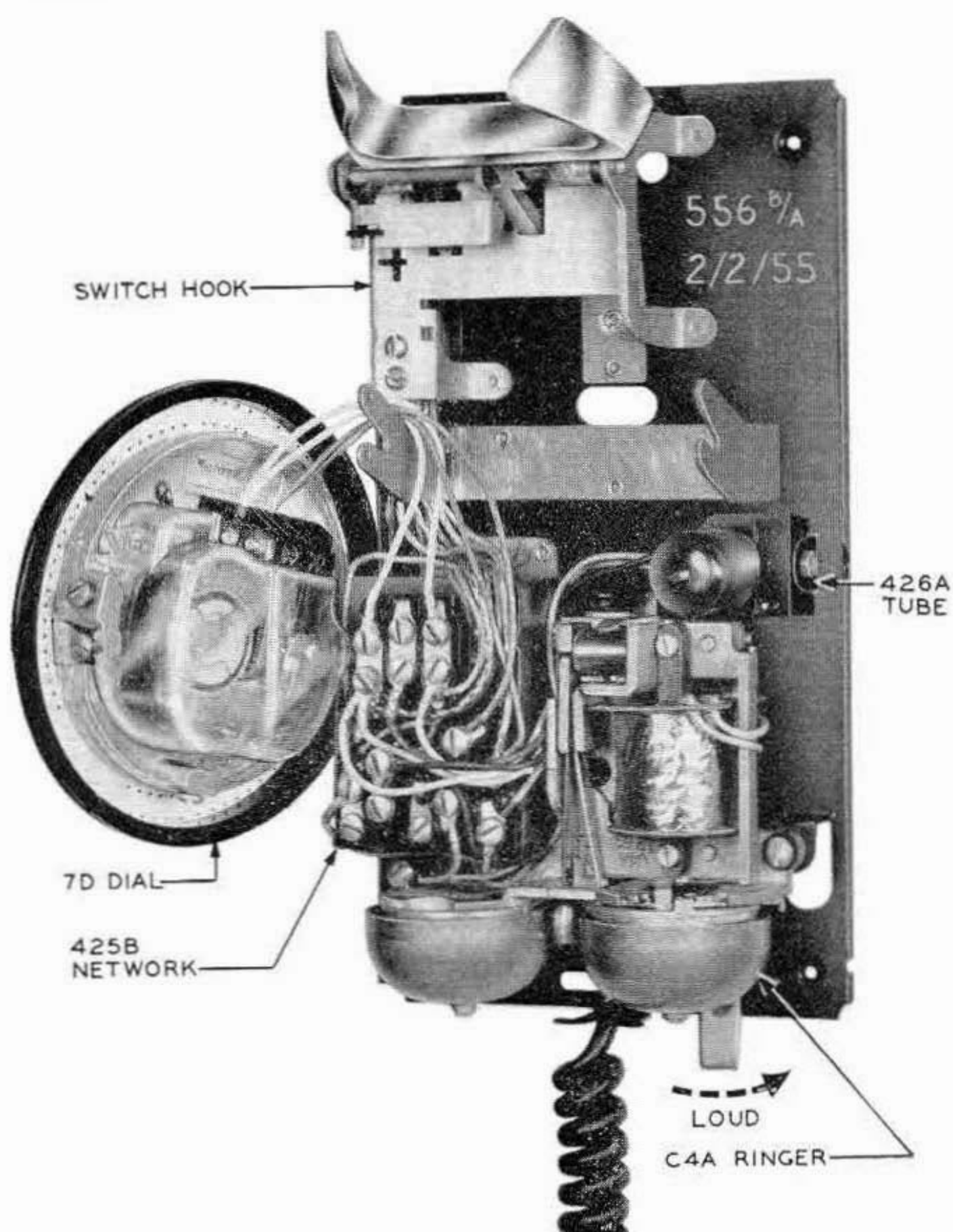


Fig. 4—556BR Telephone Set

2.02 These sets are shown, with the housing removed, in Figs. 3, 4, and 5. The components of these sets are interchangeable with the components of the 500-type sets.

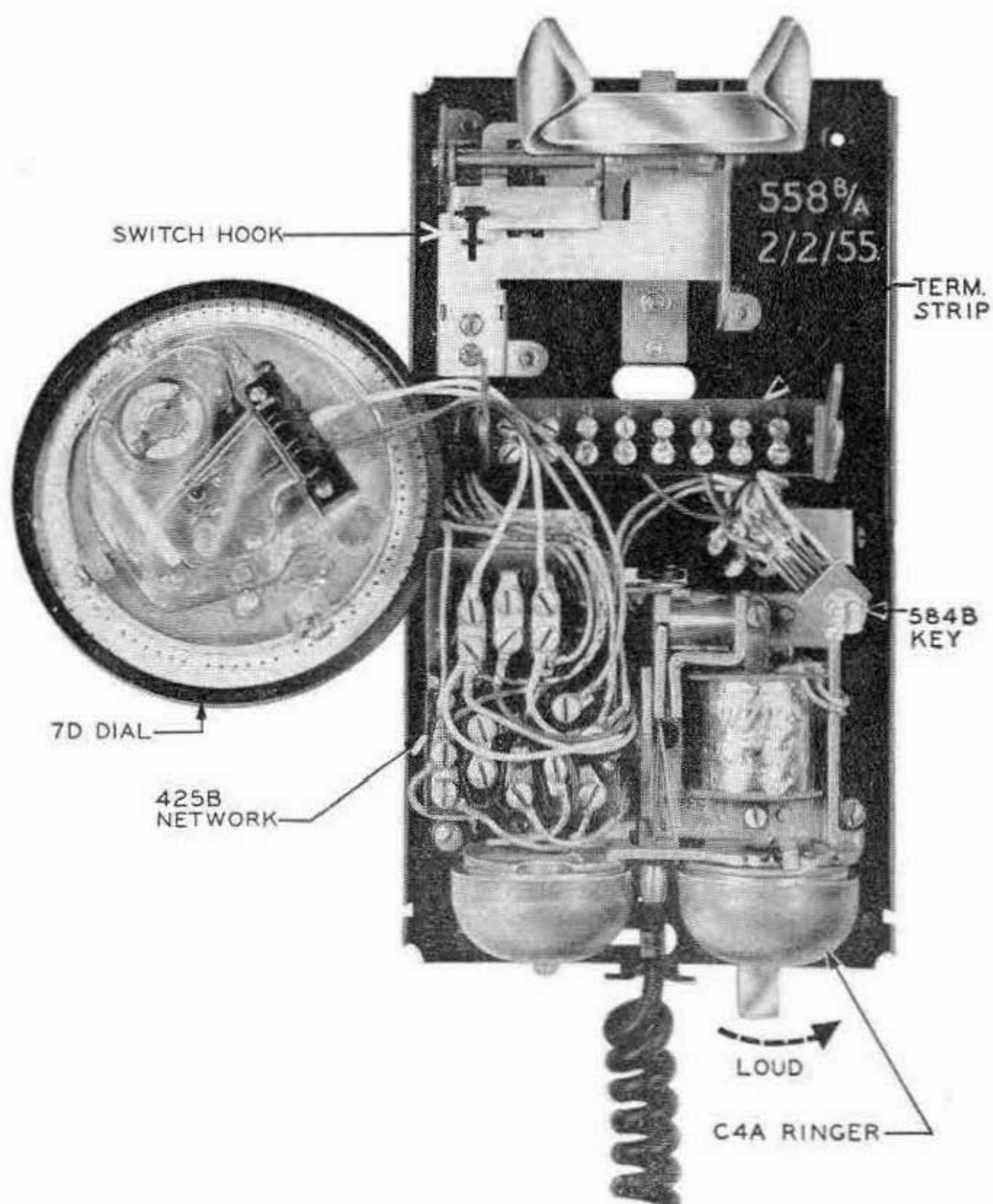


Fig. 5—558BR Telephone Set
