## 502, 510, AND 511 TYPES

### **DESCRIPTION AND USE**

#### 1.00 GENERAL

1.01 This addendum supplements Section C32.540, Issue 3. It is issued to add information on 502-, 510-, and 511-type telephone sets in color and the 511-type telephone set for use with speakerphone system 1A.

### 2.00 DESCRIPTION

2.09 Change Table A as follows:

Note: The sets listed in Table A, when equipped with a spring handset cord, will have the suffix R added to the code. For example, the 502A-3 will be coded 502AR-3. Sets ordered with the suffix R will be equipped with the spring handset cords when received.

2.10 Change to read: The 502A/B, 510A/B, 510E/F, and 511C/D telephone sets are available in the eight standard full colors and the eight standard two-tone colors as well as in black. For complete color information, refer to Section C32.544, Issue 2, Telephone Sets, 500 Series, Supplies.

3.05 Change to read: 511C/D: This set is intended for use in 1A key telephone systems and speakerphone system 1A. It is equipped with a single combination turn-push button key for 2-line pickup plus signaling, and an exclusion switch (see 2.02). It has a D16D (16-conductor) mounting cord and replaces 410CA, CC, 411AA, AC, CA, CC, and 511A/B telephone sets. An auxiliary terminal block, shown in Fig. 5, is not required with 511C/D sets.
