3A COMMUNICATION SYSTEM (HOSPITAL INTERPHONE) IDENTIFICATION

1. GENERAL

- 1.01 This section is reissued to:
 - Show list numbers for 12-button TOUCH-TONE® dial
 - Show the M2ER nurse call cord replacement
 - Show 35C3A dial recommended to replace 25Y3 dial
 - Show 2220B hand telephone set recommended to replace 1220A hand telephone set

2. PURPOSE

- Intercommunication system between nurse's position and up to 40 patient stations used in conjunction with a hospital's PBX or Centrex system.




Fig. 1—Block Diagram - 3A Communication System

- Fig. 1 shows a block diagram of the 3A communication system.

3. ORDERING GUIDE

 Tables A, B, and C provide ordering information for the various components of the 3A communication system.

4. COLOR

- Nurse control console, patient telephone set, and associated components are available in colors specified in Tables A and B.
- Equipment cabinet (J53038A-1, List 1 and List 2) available in two-tone gray only.

5. DESIGN FEATURES

 Patient-to-nurse or nurse-to-patient signaling with option of hands-free or handset operation.

- Access to CO, PBX, or Centrex lines at console using either handset or speakerphone, if provided.
- Access to CO, PBX, or Centrex lines at patient station, using handset only.
- Audible and visual signaling at 60 ipm on patient-to-nurse calls (NURSE pushbutton).
- Continuous audible and 120 ipm visual signaling on emergency patient-to-nurse calls (if customer-owned emergency key is provided).
- Line seizure tone when control console connects to system.
- Privacy feature at patient station.
- Automatic selection and answering of patient calls from optional remote answering stations, if provided.
- **5.01** The following features are available on an option basis:
 - Connection to customer-owned door lamps and relays.
 - Connection to customer-owned emergency key.
 - OFF position on patient ringer volume control.
 - Message waiting lamp at patient station.
 - Data jack at patient station.
 - Speakerphone at nurse console.

6. APPLICATION

 Used as an adjunct to customer's PBX or Centrex system.

7. OPERATING FEATURES

- (a) Nurse Control Console:
 - PATIENT INTERPHONE—places console in interphone mode.
 - ON-OFF-VOL—controls for 3-type speakerphone.

- (3) REMOTE ANSWER OFF-ON—turnbutton audible signal transfer key when remote answer option is provided.
- (4) PATIENT CALL LO-HI—patient call volume control.
- (b) Patient Telephone Set:
 - NURSE—red pushbutton used to signal nurses console of request for attention.

- (2) PRIVATE—pushbutton used to cutoff transmitter in patient set. Room conversation cannot be monitored at nurse console. Nurse can be heard from loudspeaker in patient set.
- (3) NORMAL—pushbutton used to release PRIVATE pushbutton and restore set to normal interphone operation.
- (4) Bell System Seal—pushbutton nurse call button release. Used to cancel NURSE call from patient set.

(5) Recall switch—small rectangular pushbutton located below dial of dial-in-handset. Used to break line circuit and obtain dial tone without returning handset to base.

8. ASSOCIATED APPARATUS OR EQUIPMENT

- 2012B Transformer—used to supply power to 55-type control unit. One required for each control unit provided.
- 55-type Control Unit—control unit for 3-type speakerphone. Use 55A for 3A speakerphone;
 55B for 3B speakerphone.




Fig. 2-J53038E, List 1 Console (Rotary Dial)




Fig. 3—J53038E, List 2 Console (TOUCH-TONE) With 760A Loudspeaker for Speakerphone




Fig. 4—Patient Telephone Set With AE2 Base




Fig. 5—Equipment Cabinet, 3A Communication System
