## **PLACING FLAT RUBBER CORDAGE AT DESKS AND TABLES**

### **1. GENERAL**

1.01 This section covers a method for placing flat rubber cordage at desks, tables or other furniture, and tentatively includes ordering information for the cordage; all other material used in the installation of the cordage being covered in the section on "Station Wiring Supplies."

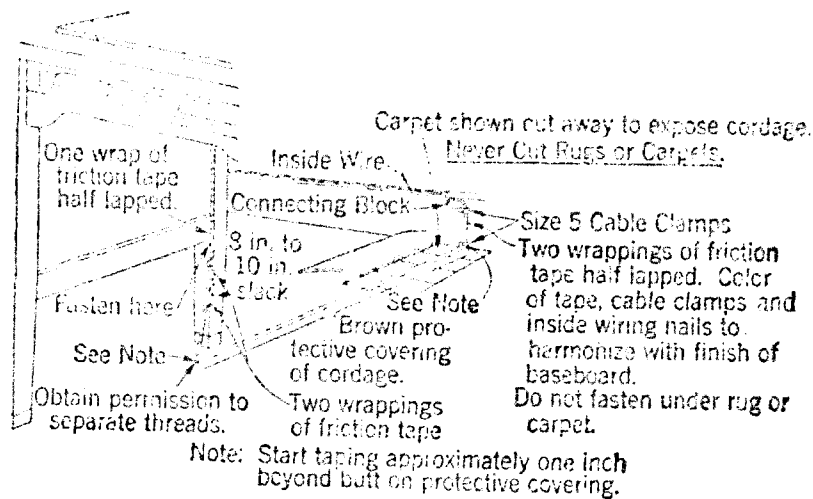
1.02 Flat rubber cordage of the type referred to herein is for use in extending station wiring under rugs or carpets, and it is intended that this method be used as an alternative method for the under carpet method shown in the section covering "Placing Wire and Cable at Desks and Tables."

### **2. MATERIAL**

**Cordage:** **KS-7144 Four-Conductor No. 18 Gauge Flat Rubber Cordage.**

### **3. PLACING CORDAGE**

3.01 Place flat rubber cordage under rugs or carpets from wall to desks or tables as shown in the following typical illustration:
