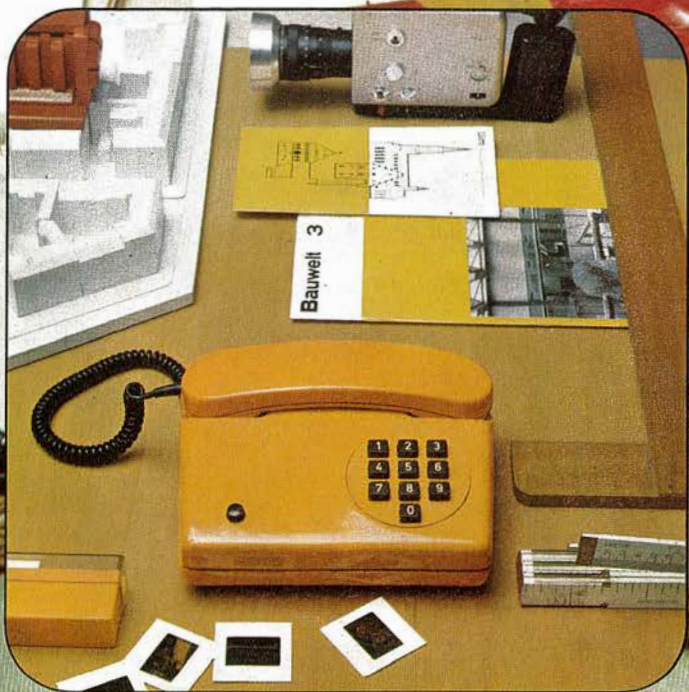
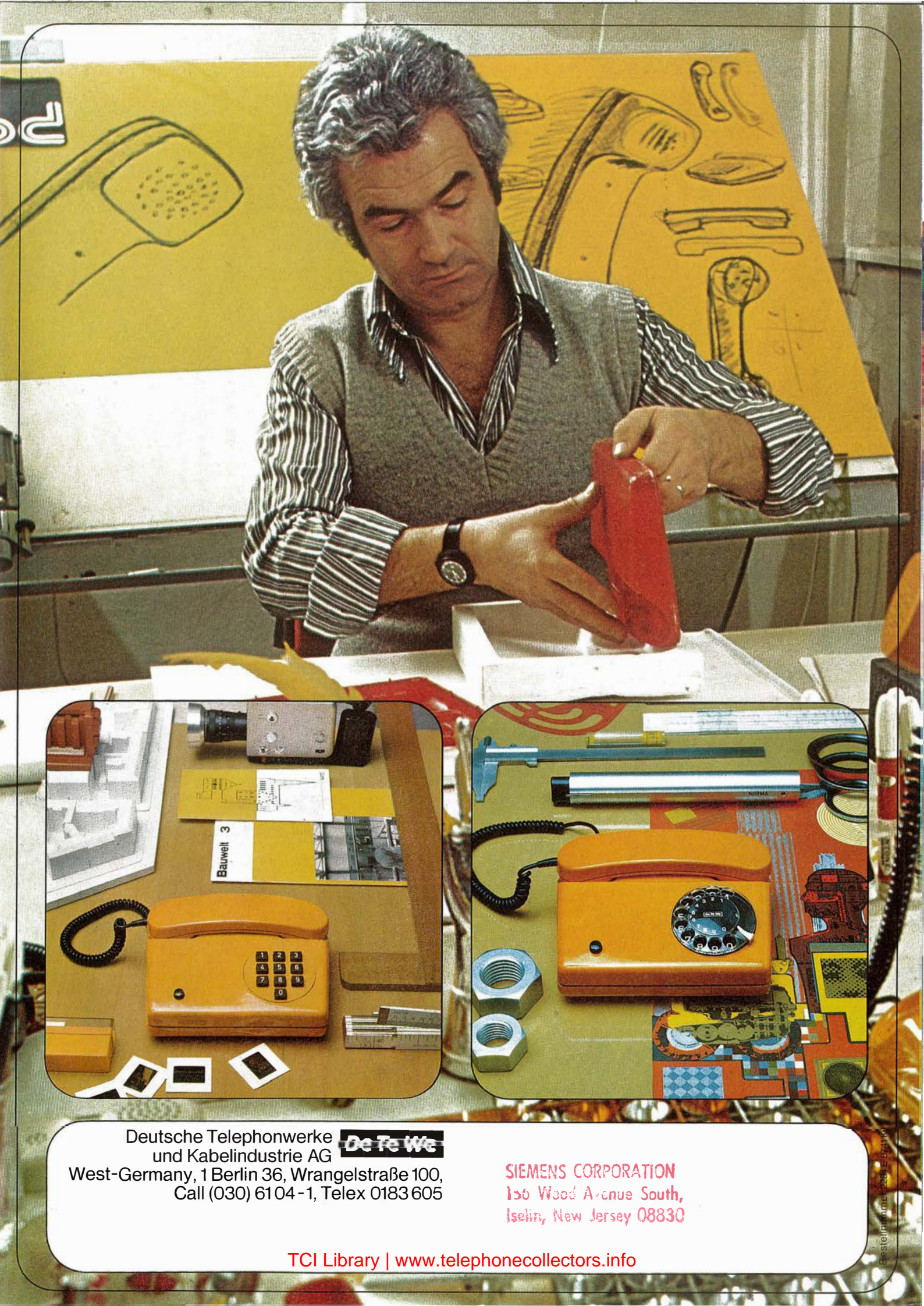
People are scarcely aware of these facts when they use the telephone. Only after analysing the problems and evaluating the results did we come up with valuable ideas.

But it's still no more expensive than the traditional phone and can be installed in no time at all. The "contast" phone is simple and easy to connect to any extension line.
