88-Type Quick-Connect Hardware and Tools

The use of the 88-type wiring blocks and connecting blocks (and associated hardware) was previously standardized for use in Pacific Telephone.

We have now been informed that some redesigning of 88-type blocks and associated tools was necessary due to design problems. Additional developmental work is going on to provide new wiring/connecting blocks for multiple terminations required on complex installations.

At this time there is a definite compatibility problem when the 88-type blocks are used or mixed with existing terminations used in complex installations.

Due to the compatibility problems and high associated tool cost, we in I&R should not use the 88-type wiring system at this time.
